**SOME HELPFUL HINTS  
TO REDUCE THE COST OF YOUR  
MOVE**

- Apartment moving - reserve elevators.
- Home or townhouse moving - arrange street parking.
- Appliances should be serviced, cords rolled, etc.
- Fixtures should be taken down early
- Mover is not responsible for jewellery, currency, documents, furs etc.
- Dresser drawers can be left with normal content in them such as clothing. Be sure to remove all breakables and jewellery. Do not pack additional items into dresser.
- All cartons must be sealed for proper handling.
- Bundle items as much as possible
- Fragile unpacked items such as glass, lamps, lampshades, and picture frames will be transported at OWNER'S RISK unless prepacking service is arranged.
- Check closets, basements and garages once truck is loaded.
- Plants are moved at OWNER'S RISK.
- Ensure everything is packed and ready to go.
- Disassemble beds and large items.
- Move boxes and smaller items in your car.

**NOTE:** *Since your move is charged by the hour, time is the important factor. If you follow these hints, the time and therefore the cost of your move will be reduced.*

**Recommended Box Guide:**

2 Cu. carton - pack books, records, etc.

4 Cu. carton - pack lampshades, clothes, pots & pans, towels, etc.

6 Cu. cartons - pack linens, pillows, bed clothes.

**NOTE:** *Do not pack heavy items in large boxes.*

**BE CAREFUL:** *There are items that movers are unable to load onto their trucks. Items such as, paint, alcohol, solvents, lighter fluid, greasy mops or rags, aerosol cans, and propane tanks.*

**Keep Receipts:**

Many of your moving expenses may be tax deductible. So remember to request and keep receipts for all expenditures related to your move.

Then consult Revenue Canada and request the form "claim For Moving Expenses," T1-M, to find out which of your moving expenses can be deducted.
